To Our Green Chimneys Families,

We received notification today that a staff member on our Brewster campus has tested positive for COVID-19. The individual was last at work on Sunday, January 10<sup>th</sup> and is currently isolating.

We have also been notified that two students have tested positive. Neither has been on campus since December 18<sup>th</sup> and they will not return to campus until they finish their isolation period and are free of symptoms.

We are coordinating with the Putnam County Department of Health and are closely monitoring the situation with all individuals on campus. We continue to follow all safety guidelines and have determined, along with the Department of Health that we do not need to suspend in-person instruction at this time.

Parents should continue to monitor their child each day for symptoms of COVID-19, which could include fever, loss of taste or smell, headache, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, sore throat, fatigue, congestion or runny nose, body aches and/or nausea.

If your child develops any symptoms, contact your child's health care provider as soon as possible. **If your child tests positive for COVID-19**, please call the Green Chimneys Health Center at 845.279.2995 ext. 253.

Maintaining best practices for safe social distancing, properly wearing a mask, diligent hand washing and sanitizing are our best defense against exposure.
